Acknowledging Funding from Canadian Frailty Network

Guidelines for Researchers & Trainees



On an ongoing basis, research and knowledge translation projects, and Fellows and Summer Students and their supervisors funded by Canadian Frailty Network (formerly TVN) should acknowledge this financial support in all electronic, print and verbal communications concerning the project. This includes brochures, posters, websites, surveys, journal submissions, conference papers, and other presentations.

Preferred Method of Acknowledgement

The preferred method of acknowledgement includes the Network logo, as well as text relating to funding:

If space is limited

If space is limited, a text-only mention is acceptable:

This research is funded by Canadian Frailty Network (Technology Evaluation in the Elderly Network), which is supported by the Government of Canada through the Networks of Centres of Excellence (NCE) program.

Text references to Canadian Frailty Network

When you refer to the Network in the text of a document, the first mention in copy should be "Canadian Frailty Network." Subsequent mentions in the same document can be "CFN."

Overall guidelines when using the Network logo

Format: The logo must be used as provided and can never be altered. It can be resized proportionately within a document by clicking on the logo, then positioning your cursor on one of the circles in each corner.

Colour: The logo colours must be as in the file provided by the Network.

Placement: "White space" equal to between the outside points of one cell in the honeycomb symbol in the logo must be maintained around the logo. No text or graphics may be placed within this "white space."

Minimum Size: The logo must always be large enough to be legible. It may never be any smaller than 0.375 inches (95 mm) wide as measured from the far left point of the honeycomb symbol to the right of the "n" in Canadian.

Trademark: Whenever you use the Network logo, please footnote its ownership:
