

## **Pneumococcal Vaccination Research Study**

### **VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR ONLINE RESEARCH STUDY ON PNEUMOCOCCAL VACCINATION BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OTTAWA**

The goal of this study is to assess whether an **educational intervention** improves pneumococcal vaccine uptake, willingness to be vaccinated, and knowledge of and attitudes towards pneumococcal vaccines. Half of the participants will watch a short, web-based educational video about pneumococcal vaccination and a reminder email to get vaccinated. The other half of participants will only receive a reminder email. In addition, participants will be asked to fill out two web-based surveys (one at baseline and one 4-6 months later).

- Living in any Canadian province
- Not having received the pneumococcal vaccine
